



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR CRUISE

ICELAND'S NATURAL BEAUTY

Effective from June 24, 2021

The information included in this document is based on current Iceland regulations and Viking COVID-19 Protocols and Procedures. Both are reviewed continuously and may be updated as your cruise departure date approaches. Please be sure to check this information again in advance of your departure for any changes to requirements.

The chart below highlights the items that must be completed in order to ensure your entry to Iceland.

Viking Vaccination Requirement: Beginning on May 22, 2021, with the official restart of limited operations—and remaining in effect at least through September 30, 2021—all Viking sailings will be available exclusively for vaccinated guests.

In addition to government regulations within the destinations that we will visit, Viking has introduced its own Health and Safety protocol enhancements which have been implemented to protect our guests and crew as the global vaccine rollout moves forward. Viking medical advisors and operations teams will continue to monitor global vaccination rates and entry requirements and we will adjust our protocol and policies as needed to ensure the safety and well-being of our guests and crew.

VeriFLY: To expedite the embarkation process, Viking has partnered with Daon Inc., an independent third-party vendor, to digitally pre-verify guests' vaccination status through the company's VeriFLY app. You will receive an email from Viking with instructions on how to complete the vaccination verification on the VeriFLY app. Please complete the VeriFLY vaccine certification process at least 10 days prior to your cruise.

Digital Health Survey: Five to seven days before your departure, you will be sent a link to the Viking Digital Health Survey that will need to be completed and submitted on www.myvikingjourney.com. Developed by scientific and medical advisors, the survey will only take a minute to submit and verify your wellness prior to travel. Depending on your dates of travel, Viking may require you to submit verification of your COVID-19 vaccination status as part of the Digital Health Survey.

Iceland Pre-Registration/Pre-Departure Requirements for UK/US Guest Entry (Iceland):

1. Ensure you have proof of complete vaccination for COVID-19.
2. **72 hours prior** to arrival in Iceland, you will need to fill out a pre-registration form at <https://visit.covid.is/registration>, which will require the following 2 steps:

Step 1: Health Declaration and mobile phone verification. You will be asked for your mobile number and will be required to request a verification number before you can continue. When you receive the verification number, enter and submit it as directed.

Step 2: Registration information

- a. This includes entry of the following information
 - Country of departure
 - Flight number/Arrival date (refer to your air ticket)
 - Date of birth
 - Family name = last name; given name(s) = first and middle names as they appear on your passport.
 - Nationality
 - Gender
 - Email address
 - Country of residence
 - Departure date
 - Mobile number
- b. You must then **“Choose what you are doing upon arrival to Iceland”**:
 - i. **Select: “Present a valid certificate for exception/other documents” (vaccination certificate)**
 - ii. Confirmation: check appropriate boxes
 - iii. Select: Confirm and Send
- c. You will receive a confirmation email with a link to a barcode that must be presented upon your arrival to Iceland. Please print or have this available on you mobile phone.

Important: If you are a cruise-only guest and arranging your own air, please ensure that you have checked local requirements for your arrival port and contacted your air carrier for their requirements.

Health/Travel Documents: Please remember to bring the appropriate travel and health documentation to ensure all requirements have been accommodated.

1. Proof of Vaccination certificate—you will be asked to present a printed copy when you enter Iceland.
2. Confirmation of pre-registration for visiting Iceland (either print your barcode, or have the confirmation email available to click the link and show upon arrival in Iceland.)
3. Valid passport plus, if applicable, a valid residency visa.

Embarkation Procedure (Iceland): Upon arrival, you may be required to take a COVID-19 test administered by the Icelandic government. This test will be in addition to the embarkation test required by Viking.

Special Note: The ship is designated as an Iceland quarantine area for Viking guests. You will be transferred to your ship as you await confirmation of a negative COVID-19 PCR test result. You will then proceed to your stateroom where you will be required to provide a saliva sample. **Please refrain from consuming any food or beverage item or smoking for at least one hour before submitting your saliva sample. While waiting for your test results, you will be able to use the public spaces on board observing current mask and social distancing requirements.**

You will also need to undergo the following COVID-19 screening prior to your cruise:

- Temperature check (a temperature reading of less than 100.4°F/38°C).
- Questions in relation to your general health, COVID-19 symptoms, or possible exposure.
- Accept and agree to using contact-tracing technology during your cruise.
- Complete any required check-in procedures.

During Your Cruise: You will be tested periodically, on board the ship, as required by Viking and in coordination with the government of Iceland.

Disembarkation/Return Flight: Prior to leaving your Viking ship, you will be required to take a final COVID-19 test to satisfy the requirement for pre-flight testing before arrival in your country.

Pre-Cruise Timeline Summary:

1. At least **14 days prior** to departure, be fully vaccinated with a FDA/WHO approved COVID-19 vaccine.
2. **72 hours prior to departure**, fill out a pre-registration form for visiting Iceland.
3. **When you travel**—be prepared to show proof of your vaccination, a valid passport and confirmation of Iceland Pre-Registration and Health Declaration (barcode or confirmation email).
